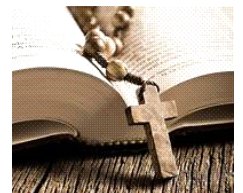

The Uttlesford Hub Telephone Befriending Team



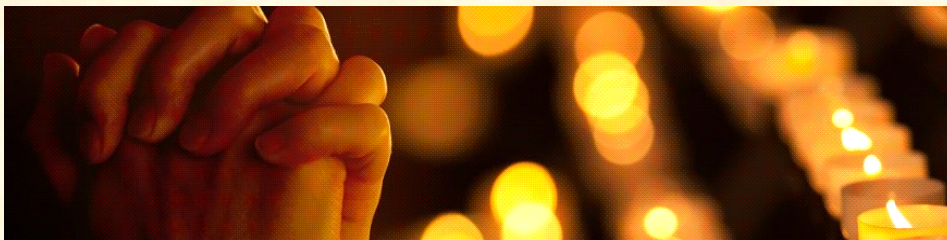
